Access to preventive services by Medicare beneficiaries improved dramatically in 2011. That year, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) eliminated the deductible and coinsurance for most preventive services—including the initial preventive physician examination (IPPE)—and waived deductibles for tests that began as colorectal cancer screening tests, but during which become diagnostic or therapeutic.

Although there are no official, specific documentation guidelines for these services, based on recommendations from the AMA, the American Academy of Family Physicians, the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force, the American College of Physicians Internal Medicine, and the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology, here is a breakdown of the information you should see documented in the review of a preventive medicine service based on the patient’s age and gender:

Recommended Ways to Document and Report a Preventive Visit ...

Preventive Care. You and your family may be eligible for some important preventive services at no additional cost to you. If your plan is subject to the new requirements, you may not have to pay a copayment, co-insurance, or deductible to receive recommended preventive health services, such as screenings, vaccinations, and counseling.

The federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) requires non-grandfathered health plans to cover certain “recommended preventive services” as identified by PPACA under the preventive care services benefit, without cost sharing to members when provided by network physicians.
