Excel uses a special type of notation to handle these types of references. Referencing cells in other worksheets To use a reference to a cell in another worksheet in the same workbook, use this format:

### Referencing cells outside the worksheet - Microsoft Excel 2010

1). In the formula, E:\Excel file\ is the full file path of the unopened workbook, test.xlsx is the name of the workbook, Sheet2 is the sheet name which contains the cell value you need to reference from, and A:A,2,1 means the cell A2 will be referenced in the closed workbook. You can change them based on your needs.

### How to reference or link value in unopened/closed Excel ...

External references contain a reference to another workbook, such as [Budget.xlsx]. Tips: Click any column header to sort the column, and group all of the external references together. You can group multiple items with the Shift or Ctrl keys and Left-click if you want to delete multiple items at once.

### How to create drop down list from another workbook in Excel?

Note: To use this reference, you have to activate the R1C1 reference from the File > Options > Excel Options > Formulas > Working with Formulas > Check R1C1 reference style. Use defined names as reference. For example, =INDIRECT("old\_value"), =INDIRECT("new\_value") where old\_value = A5 and new\_value=B5. A reference to a cell as a text string.

### How to reference cell in another Excel sheet based on cell ...

We want to reverse the sample text using the UDF "ReverseText" from "Reversing Characters In String.xlsm". We can use a User Defined Function (UDF) from another workbook like this: =OtherWorkbookFullName!FunctionName (CellReference) To use the UDF "ReverseText" in "MainFile", we also have to define the full file name, along with an extension followed by an exclamation mark (!) in front of the UDF.
